



Enclosed please find enrollment papers for the 2026-2027 school year. We are a faith-based preschool striving to provide the absolute best in early childhood education in a warm, nurturing environment. We comply with all Department of Children and Youth requirements and exceed the expectations in curriculum from the Ohio Department of Education. Preschool will be held Tuesday through Friday. Parents may choose which days and times work the best for their schedule.

Class Options:

- Our **Tiny Tots class** is for our youngest learners. Children **who are potty trained and 2.5 years old before 8/25/2026 are eligible**. This class also works well for children who may do better with smaller class sizes. This class is limited to eight children and will always have 2 staff members. Parents may choose which days, Tuesday through Friday, the child attends. Preschool runs 8:30-11:30. Afternoon care is also available until 5:30 pm.
- Our **Early Learner's class** for children who are **3 after 10/1/26** is held Tuesday through Friday mornings from 8:30-11:30. Parents may choose which days, Tuesday through Friday, work the best for their schedule. Afternoon care is also available until 5:30 pm.
- Our **Pre-k class is for children who have turned 4 before 8/1/26** and has the option of attending half days until noon or full days until 3:00. We are anticipating needing 2 classes for 4-year-olds. Placement will be determined by the number of applicants. Nap is not part of our afternoon schedule but is available at parent's request. Care from 3 – 5:30 pm is also available.

Needed to enroll:

- *Completed Good Neighbor Place Registration Form (all students – light pink)
- *Completed Child Enrollment and Health Information Form (all students light pink)
- *\$50.00 registration fee per family, regardless of payment options chosen (all students)
- Medical statement completed and signed by a physician by the first day of school, (hot pink) ***please be sure to attach a copy of your child's shot record.***

*No slot will be held without this information submitted into The Good Neighbor Place office; however, **slots are filled on a 1st come 1st served basis.**

Tuition options are diagramed on the next page, including information about the Ohio Early Childhood Education Grant. There are only twelve spaces available for grant funding. Children must be aged three before October 1, 2026, to qualify, and family income must fall on the included income chart. Please take advantage of this opportunity if you qualify. Children enrolled through the grant must attend a minimum of 12.5 hours (4 mornings of preschool per week).
